
Other Invertebrates

Aside from arachnids and insects, several myriapods (centipedes and millipedes) have been observed in Vistoso Trails Nature Preserve (on iNaturalist). The millipede at right has not yet been identified. This section will be expanded should additional species be observed.

Scientific name: Scolopendra polymorpha

Notes: Most often seen at night after rain, these centipedes are venomous and should not be handled. Larger giant desert centipedes and nonvenomous desert millipedes also likely live within the preserve.
