

# Other Invertebrates

Aside from arachnids and insects, only one other invertebrate has been observed in Vistoso Trails Nature Preserve (on iNaturalist): a centipede. This section will be expanded should additional species be observed.

**Common name:** Common Desert Centipede

**Scientific name:** *Scolopendra polymorpha*

**Notes:** Most often seen at night after rain, these centipedes are venomous and should not be handled. Larger Giant Desert Centipedes and nonvenomous Desert Millipedes also likely live within the preserve.
