



Vistoso Trails Nature Preserve Checklists

Please print these checklists as a fun way to track your wildlife sightings while out exploring **Vistoso Trails Nature Preserve**. Only a selection of the most common plants and animals are included on these lists. The pages referenced are the pages on which the given organism is described and pictured in the **Vistoso Trails Field Guide**, available online (free of charge) here: <https://www.preservevistoso.org/field-guide>.

If you are interested, we would also encourage you to create an account on **iNaturalist** (<https://www.inaturalist.org/signup>). You can use iNaturalist both to record what you see using photos from a cell phone or camera, and also to help with getting identifications of any flora or fauna that you observe. This is of course totally optional!

The following nine pages are divided into six lists. Within each category you'll find the most common and most likely to be noted species within the preserve. Blank fields have also been provided for anything you see that is not listed, and there is room for additional notes on the final page. Good luck!
