

Other Invertebrates

Aside from arachnids and insects, only one other invertebrate has been observed in Vistoso Trails Nature Preserve (on iNaturalist): a centipede. This section will be expanded should additional species be observed.

Common name: Common Desert Centipede

Scientific name: *Scolopendra polymorpha*

Notes: Most often seen at night after rain, these centipedes are venomous and should not be handled. Larger Giant Desert Centipedes and nonvenomous Desert Millipedes also likely live within the preserve.
